

SAHLBERG in the Encyclopedia of German Family-Owned Companies

This year, SAHLBERG was included by the publisher *Deutsche Standards* in the "Lexikon der deutschen Familieunternehmen" (Encyclopedia of German Family-Owned Companies). With this publication, publisher Florian Langenscheidt brings family-owned companies to the center of public awareness so that they will be recognized for what they are: the backbone of German society. Some 60 percent of all jobs and 80 percent of all apprenticeships in Germany are provided by family businesses.

Founded in Munich in 1907, SAHLBERG can look back on a long history and is now managed by Dr. Mathias Sahlberg in the fourth generation. Starting from a store for rubber products, the company has developed into a comprehensive technical dealer and service provider with 180 employees.



SAHLBERG could not be omitted from the encyclopedia. In addition to hard facts, the reference book contains interesting stories about the families and the respective companies. The social involvement of families is also highlighted.

A total of 1,000 German companies are presented in the publication. Thus, the "Encyclopedia of German Family-Owned Companies" is an excellent research base for those wishing to deal with the German economy, its players and, of course, SAHLBERG itself.
